THIS PERMIT IS GRANTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 4513.34 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS.

THE MOVER AGREES TO PROTECT THE TRAVELING PUBLIC AND AT ALL TIMES INDEMNIFY AND SAVE HARMLESS WOOD COUNTY AGAINST ALL DAMAGES THAT MAY OCCUR THROUGH THE USE OF THIS PERMIT. THIS PERMIT DOES NOT APPLY TO ANY PART OF THE MOVE OVER ANY STATE/TOWNSHIP HIGHWAY OR INSIDE THE CORPORATION LIMITS OF ANY MUNICIPALITY. THIS PERMIT IS SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE STATE HIGHWAY PATROL AND THE WOOD COUNTY SHERIFF.

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS FOR SPECIAL HAULING PERMIT

The original copy of the Special Hauling Permit and any attachments as issued shall be in the possession of the driver at all times during the progress of transportation and shall be shown on demand to any Police Officer, Deputy Sheriff, or Ohio State Highway Patrol Employee.

This specialized permit is used for the movement of over width machinery to and from job sites; the permitted vehicle and load must not exceed twelve (12.0) feet in width and be otherwise legal in accordance with sections 5577.04 through 5577.05 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Loads may consist of such equipment as small dozers or backhoes transported on straight trucks, on equipment trailers pulled by trucks, or on semi-trailers hauled by commercial tractors. Field office trailers towed on their own undercarriages may also be included.

The permit is good for an unlimited number of moves on the Wood County Road system and shall be valid for a period of one year. Be alert for overhead obstructions and be aware that posted weight/load limits, including those on pavements and bridges, shall be obeyed.

Once operating, the permit holder is entirely responsible to remain aware of the permit expiration date and assuring that a new permit is ordered in a timely manner. The permit holder is also responsible for ensuring that the permit accurately describes the vehicle and load; when it doesn't, the permit is null and void and either a revision or new permit shall be obtained.

Warning flags shall be displayed on all over dimensional vehicles and loads. Warning flags shall be 18 inches square, red or orange in color, in good repair and free of printing or other markings and shall be securely fastened by at least one corner or securely mounted on a staff on the permitted vehicle.

Over width vehicles and loads shall bear two flags at the widest extremities of the vehicle or load as well as one flag at each corner of the vehicle or load. Warning flags are not required to be displayed on the tractor.

The County Engineer may require a load rating be performed which shall be stamped and signed by a registered Professional Engineer in the State of Ohio for any requested loads in excess of the Ohio legal loads to cross a bridge. Any costs associated with the load rating shall be the responsibility of the Operator. The report shall state the requested overweight load can safely travel across affected bridge(s) located on the haul route map. If requested, the load rating shall be submitted to the County Engineer's Office for review and approval before the overweight load can cross the affected bridge(s). If the report lists special conditions need to be met in order to cross the bridge with the overweight load, the Operator must adhere to all the special conditions.
